It is also preferred that the candidate have academic administrative experience and excellent interpersonal/ communication skills. A record of research engagement is preferred. Responsibilities include serving as the Chair of the Department of Rehabilitation Sciences, overseeing departmental activities in research, teaching, and service, providing innovative fiscal management for department growth, and providing administrative oversight to existing and future Department Center(s) of Excellence.

The University provides outstanding opportunities for faculty in an environment that encourages and supports innovation and collaboration. Qualified applicants may be considered for an Endowed Chair. The Department of Rehabilitation Sciences has strong professional education programs with close collaboration between physical therapy, occupational therapy, and other OUHSC units. The entry level programs offer DPT and MOT (transitioning to doctorate) degrees with students and faculty on both the Oklahoma City and Tulsa campuses. The Department has an excellent and established Doctor of Science degree program and an interdisciplinary PhD degree in Allied Health Sciences.
